PRINCIPLES OF OPERATIONS

1. Contribute to stability and security of the unique identifiers system and root management
2. Promote competition and choice for registrants and other users
3. Forum for multi-stakeholder bottom-up development of related policy
4. Ensuring on a global basis an opportunity for participation by all interested parties

IANA News

- Root management queue reduced 35% since January 1st
- IETF queue reduced 36% since January 1st
- IANA and RIRs agreed on administrative procedures for IPv4 requests in July 2003
- IANA agreed to follow the new global IPv4 allocation policy as of Montevideo since it passed policy forum in all four regions

IPv6

- TLD glue in the root
 - RSSAC recommendation is before the ICANN Board
 - I'm working on a paper for the board
 - Hope to have it wrapped up at the May board meeting
- Large request from RIPE
 - Significant deviation from previous allocation patterns, therefore required review
 - Active discussion with IAB is in progress

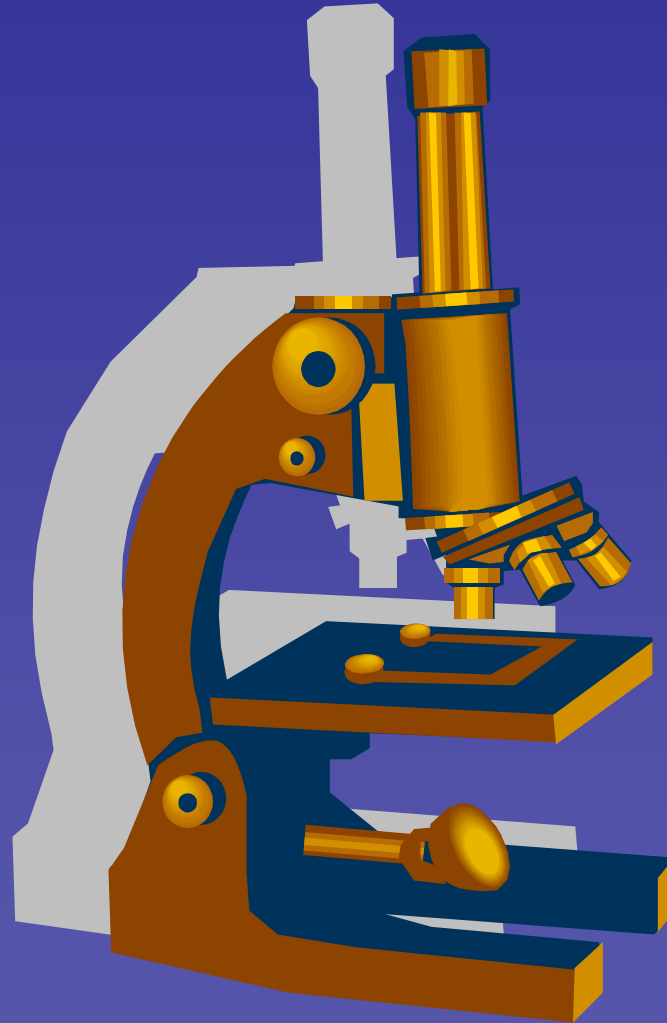
