Timing of input to AP / Budget

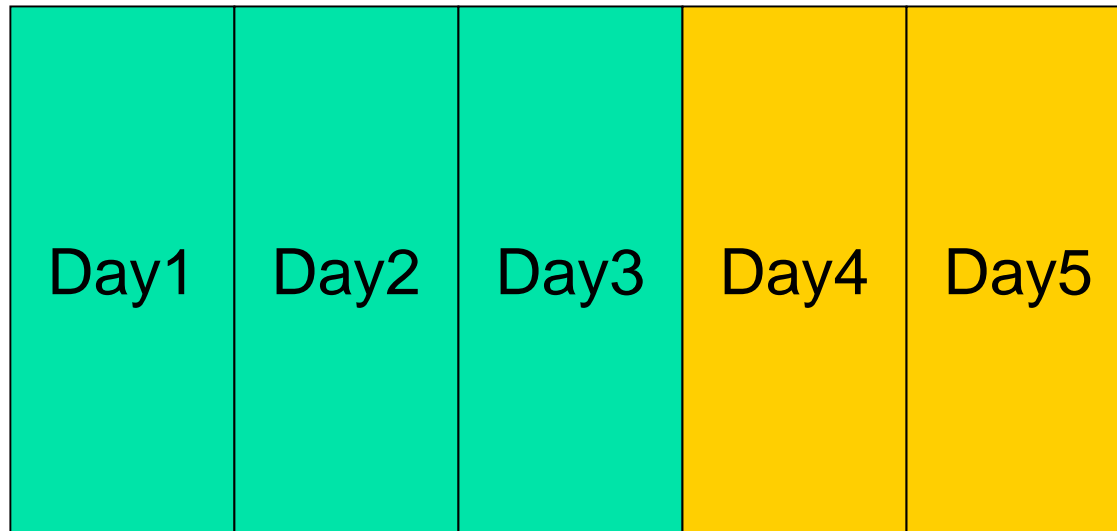




Increase focus of work

A new RIPE meeting plan?

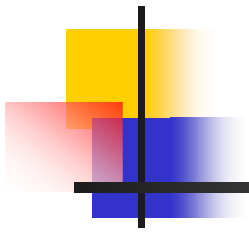
