IPv4 Allocation Policy

- RIRs submitted unified policy proposal to ASO based on drafts from the four regions
- ASO Submitted draft policy to ICANN board on 3 September 2004
 - <http://aso.icann.org/docs/aso-001-2.pdf>
- ICANN Board planning to consider the proposal at the September meeting
- Current ASO MoU does not specify review procedure for global policy
- Policy already being used by IANA, as of April 2004

Plans for the future

- Better template system for root management
 - Feedback from ccTLD managers has been incredibly helpful in this process
- PGP and other authentication methods
 - Staff signing announcements
 - Need to start verifying keys from stakeholders
- Workflow/Request Tracking system(s)
- IANA mailing list for TLD managers
 - Historical precedent, done by Jon Postel, continued for a while by IANA staff

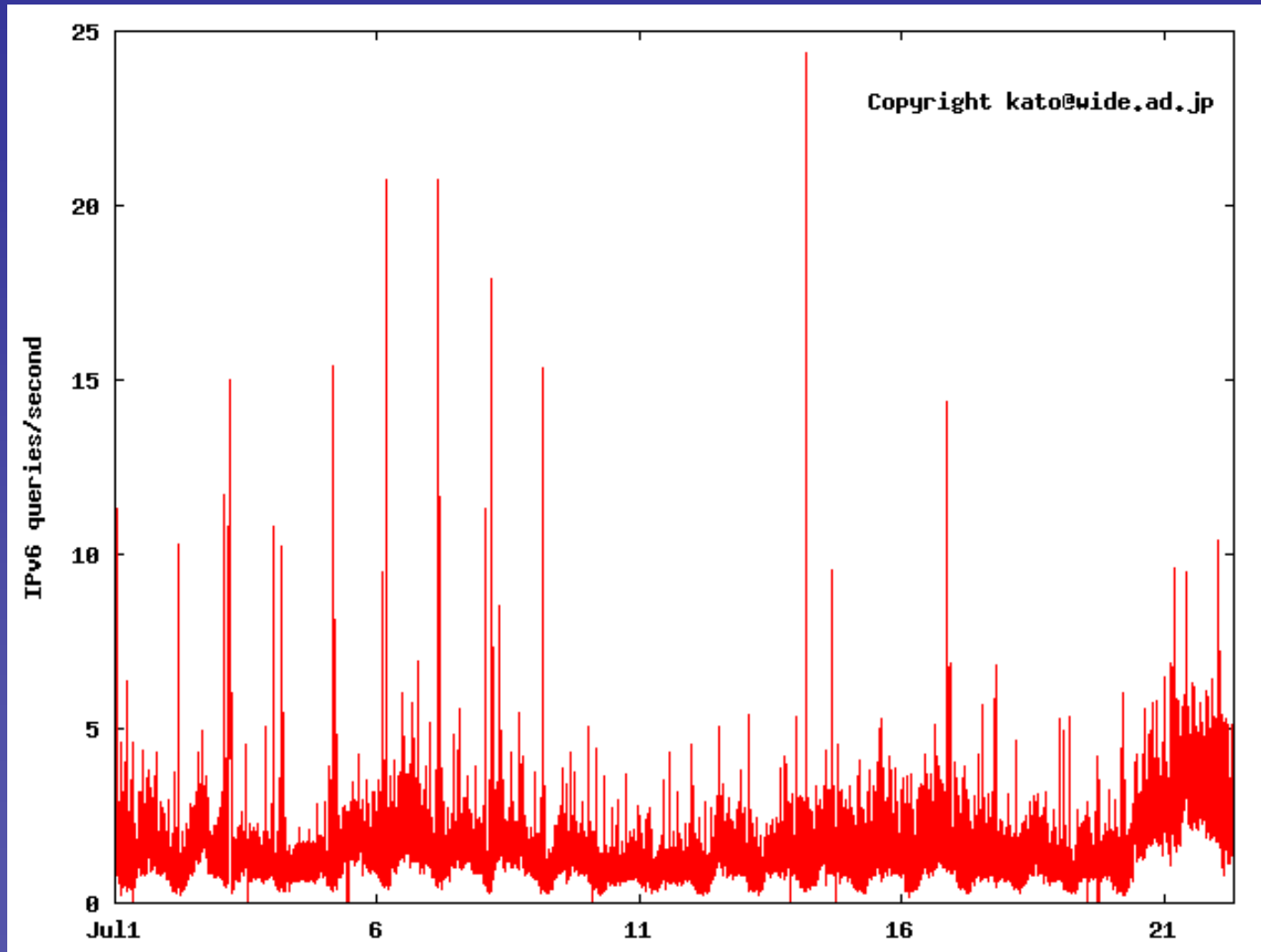

- ccTLD managers submitted requests to IANA
- IANA staff referred the question to ICANN structures for advice
- RSSAC adopted the question, conducted an exhaustive study
- December 2003 – RSSAC recommendation to ICANN board
- July 2004 – Publication of Delegation Data Procedure

IPv6 Requests for JP



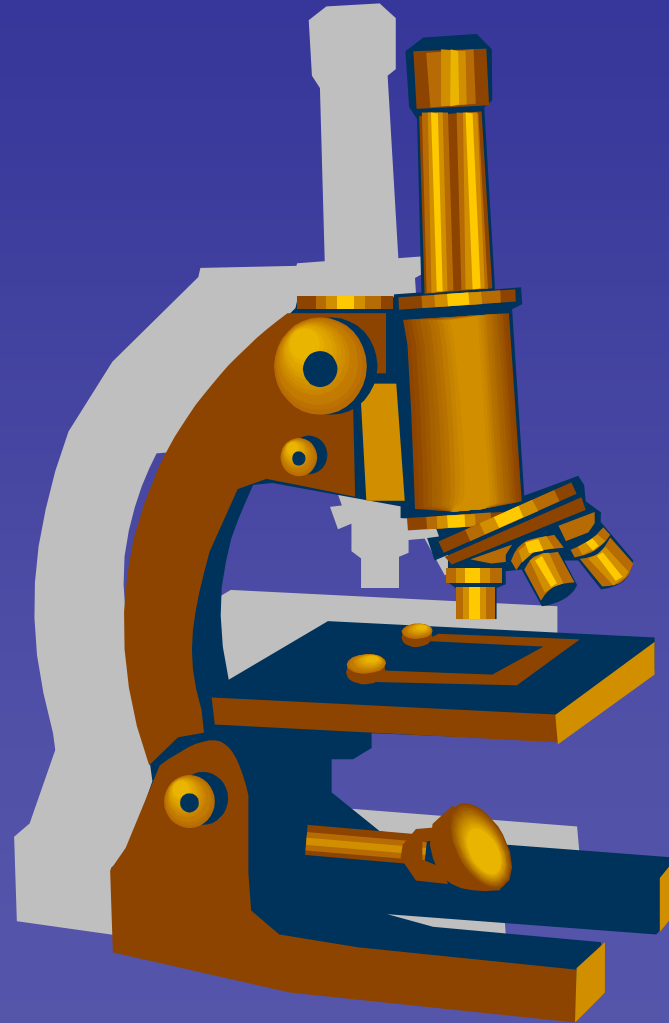
