# ENUM Monitoring needed

- Allow DNSMON services to monitor ENUM zones
- ENUM zones already monitored
  - .3.4.e164.arpa (Austria)
  - .1.3.e164.arpa (Netherlands)
  - .0.2.4.e164.arpa (Czech Republic)
- Only ENUM Tier 1 zones
- Need to change ripe-342

# ripe-342 changes

- Change policy document and contract
- Add definitions of ENUM Tier 1 zone and administrator
- Add “and ENUM Tier 1” to every place where TLD is
- Change contract in 3) DNS Monitoring Service Agreement

# Status

- Proposal sent to ncc-service-wg
- Discussion ongoing
- Some wording changes proposed:
  - not mix TLD and ENUM
  - use ENUM Tier 1 explicitly
- Number of concerns raised:
  - DNSMON not core service
  - distortion of market
  - costs not clear
  - request need to come and be accepted from Administrator only
